Section 1. (a) The state board of regents shall submit a report to the legislature that provides a detailed explanation of why in-state tuition and fees at the university of Kansas and Kansas state university have risen so much more than tuition and fees at other state educational institutions.

- (b) A resolution accepting the report specified in subsection (a) shall require a majority vote of the members of the house of representatives and the senate in order for the report to be deemed accepted by the legislature.
- Sec. 2. Until the report specified in section 1 is accepted by the legislature: (a) The state board of regents shall not approve any increase in in-state tuition or fees at the university of Kansas or Kansas state university; and (2) increases in the in-state tuition and fees at other state educational institutions shall be limited to the percentage increase in the consumer price index for the Kansas City metropolitan area, all goods, all urban consumers, as officially reported by the bureau of labor statistics of the United States department of labor, or its successor index.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
