AN ACT repealing K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 22-4913, concerning offender res-10idency restrictions; relating to the prohibition of local residential re-11 12 strictions; amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 22-4913 and repealing 13 the existing section. 1415 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 16Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 22-4913 is hereby amended to read as follows: 22-4913. (a) Except as provided further, on and after 17the effective date of this act, cities and counties shall be prohibited 18from adopting or enforcing any ordinance, resolution or regula-1920tion establishing residential restrictions for offenders as defined 21by K.S.A. 22-4902, and amendments thereto. The provisions of this 22 section shall expire on June 30, 2008. 23 The prohibition set forth in subsection (a) shall not apply to any (b)city or county residential licensing or zoning program for correctional 24 25placement residences that includes regulations for the housing of such 26 offenders. (c) As used in this section, "correctional placement residence" means 27a facility that provides residential services for individuals or offenders 2829 who reside or have been placed in such facility due to any one of the 30 following situations: Prior to, or instead of, being sentenced to prison; 31 (1)32 (2)received a conditional release prior to a hearing; 33 as a part of a sentence of confinement of not more than one year; (3)34 (4)a privately operated facility housing parolees; 35 received a deferred sentence and placed in a facility operated by (5)36 community corrections; or 37 (6)required court-ordered treatment services for alcohol or drug 38 abuse. 39 Correctional placement residence shall not include a single or multi-40 family dwelling or commercial residential building that provides a resi-41dence to staff and persons other than those described in paragraphs (1)42through (6). 43 Section 1. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 22-4913 is hereby repealed.
