9 AN ACT regulating traffic; requiring the wearing of helmets when op-10erating motorcycles; amending K.S.A. 8-1598 and repealing the exist-11ing section. 1213 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 8-1598 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-15 1598. (a) No person under the age of 18 years shall operate or ride upon 16 a motorcycle or a motorized bicycle, unless wearing a helmet which com-17plies with minimum guidelines established by the national highway traffic 18safety administration pursuant to the national traffic and motor vehicle 19safety act of 1966 for helmets designed for use by motorcyclists and other 20motor vehicle users. 21No person shall operate a motorcycle unless such person is wear-(b) 22 ing an eye-protective device which shall consist of protective glasses, gog-23 gles or transparent face shields which are shatter proof and impact resis-24tant, except when the motorcycle is equipped with a windscreen which 25has a minimum height of 10 inches measured from the center of the 26 handlebars. 27 (c) This section shall not apply to persons riding within an enclosed 28cab or on a golf cart, nor shall it apply to any person operating or riding 29 any industrial or cargo-type vehicle having three wheels and commonly 30 known as a truckster. 31 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-1598 is hereby repealed. 32 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
