9 AN ACT regulation traffic; concerning auxiliary driving lamps; amending
10 K.S.A. 8-1728 and repealing the existing section.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. K.S.A. 8-1728 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-
14 1728. (a) At all times specified in K.S.A. 8-1703, at least two ~~(2)~~ lighted
15 head lamps shall be displayed, one ~~(1)~~ on each side at the front of every
16 motor vehicle, except when such vehicle is parked, subject to the regu-
17 lations governing lights on parked vehicles.

18 (b) Whenever a motor vehicle equipped with head lamps as herein
19 required is also equipped with any auxiliary lamps or a spot lamp or any
20 other lamp on the front thereof projecting a beam of intensity greater
21 than ~~three hundred (300)~~ 300 candlepower, not more than a total of four
22 ~~(4)~~ of any such lamps on the front of a vehicle shall be lighted at any one
23 time when upon a highway.

24 (c) *Whenever a motor vehicle is equipped with auxiliary driving*
25 *lamps, such lamps shall not be used as a substitute for headlamps or*
26 *lighted at any time the head lamps are required to be on in the low-beam*
27 *position.*

28 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-1728 is hereby repealed.

29 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
30 publication in the statute book.
