9 AN ACT enacting the geriatric mental health act; establishing a geriatric 10service demonstration program administered by the department on 11 aging. 12 13Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. (a) The secretary of aging shall establish a geriatric service 15demonstration program to provide grants, within the limits of appropri-16 ations therefor, to providers of mental health care to the elderly. Such 17program shall be administered by the department on aging. 18Grants may be awarded by the department on aging to providers (b)19of care to older adults with mental disabilities for the purposes which may 20include one or more of the following: 21Community integration programs which enable older adults with (1)22 mental disabilities to age in the community and prevent the unnecessary 23 use of institutional care; 24 (2) improved quality of treatment programs for older adults which 25improve the quality of mental health care in the community; 26 (3) programs which integrate mental health and aging services with 27 alcohol, drug, health and other support services; 28(4) programs which make more efficient use of mental health and 29 health professionals by developing alternative service roles for parapro-30 fessionals and volunteers, including peers, and programs more effective 31in recruitment and retention of bi-lingual, bi-cultural or culturally com-32 petent staff; family support programs which provide support for family care-33 (5)34 givers, to include the provision of care to older adults by younger family members and by older adults to younger family members; 35 36 programs which have developed and implemented innovative fi-(6)37 nancing methodologies to support the delivery of best practices; 38 (7)specialized populations programs which concentrate on outreach 39 to, engagement of and effective treatment of cultural minorities; 40 programs which compile, distribute and make available informa-(8)41tion on clinical developments, program innovations and policy develop-42ments which improve the care to older adults with mental disabilities; 43 and

(9) staff training programs which offer on-going training initiatives
including improved clinical and cultural skills, evidence based geriatric
mental health skills, and the identification and management of mental,
behavioral and substance abuse disorders among older adults.

5 (c) The secretary of aging may adopt rules and regulations necessary6 to implement the provisions of this section.

7 (d) This section shall be known and may be cited as the "geriatric 8 mental health act."

9 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 10 publication in the statute book.
