9 AN ACT concerning licensure, examination and registration of public
10 accountants; relating to the education requirements for admission to
11 examination; amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 1-302a and repealing the
12 existing section.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 1-302a is hereby amended to read as
16 follows: 1-302a. (a) The education requirement prescribed by K.S.A. 1-
17 302, and amendments thereto, is satisfied by successful completion of
18 course work *approved by the board* consisting of at least 150 semester
19 hours, with a concentration in accounting, at a college or university ~~rec-~~
20 ~~ognized~~ *approved* by the board and the applicant is the holder of a bac-
21 calaureate or higher academic degree.

22 (b) An applicant for admission to take the initial examination in this
23 state as required in K.S.A. 1-302, and amendments thereto, must submit
24 evidence satisfactory to the board ~~of accountancy~~ or to the examination
25 service that the applicant has successfully completed ~~coursework~~ *course*
26 *work approved by the board* consisting of at least 150 semester hours,
27 with a concentration in accounting, at a college or university ~~recognized~~
28 *approved* by the board and that the applicant is the holder of a baccalau-
29 reate or higher academic degree.

30 (c) The board ~~of accountancy~~ may define by rules and regulations:
31 (1) The term “concentration in accounting;” ~~as the same is to be applied~~
32 ~~each place such term occurs in this section and K.S.A. 1-302b, and~~
33 ~~amendments thereto”; and (2) the type and amount of credit for course~~
34 ~~work submitted pursuant to subsections (a) and (b).~~

35 (d) ~~The board, by rules and regulations, may provide for admittance~~
36 ~~to the examination in this state of persons who will have met the education~~
37 ~~requirements, as provided in this section, within 90 days after the ex-~~
38 ~~amination to which admitted, but no report on the examination of any~~
39 ~~such person shall be made unless such person shall have met the edu-~~
40 ~~cation requirements as provided in this section. This subsection shall ex-~~
41 ~~pire on January 1, 2004.~~

42 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 1-302a is hereby repealed.
