AN ACT concerning human embryos; relating to criminal penalties. 10 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to: 14(1)Intentionally or knowingly conduct destructive research on a hu-15man embryo; 16buy, sell, receive or otherwise transfer a human embryo with the (2)17knowledge that such embryo will be subjected to destructive research; or 18(3) buy, sell, receive or otherwise transfer gametes with the knowl-19edge that a human embryo will be produced from such gametes to be 20used in destructive research. 21Upon conviction of a violation of subsection (a), a person shall be (b) 22 guilty of a severity level 5, person felony. 23 (c) As used in this section: 24 "Destructive research" means medical procedures, scientific or (1)25laboratory research or other kinds of investigation that kills or injures the 26 subject of such research. It does not include: 27 (A) In vitro fertilization and accompanying embryo transfer to a 28woman's body; or 29 any procedure that may benefit the human embryo subject to (B) 30 such tests. 31 (2)"Gamete" means a human sperm or unfertilized human ovum. 32 (3)"Human embryo" means a genetically complete living organism 33 of the species homosapiens, from the single cell stage to eight weeks 34 development, that is not located in a woman's body. 35 "Injury" means an act that would cause physical harm or damage (4)to the embryo such as: 36 37 (A) Damaging the embryo in such a way that the embryo could not 38 survive (severe damage); 39 (B) damage to the outer layer such that the embryo could not be 40 implanted; and (C) damage or removal of the cells inside of the embryo such that 4142the embryo could not develop. 43 Injury does not preclude "preimplantation genetic diagnosis (PGD)"

- 1 in which only one or two cells are removed from an early embryo to check
- 2 the genetic makeup of the embryo for genetic disease.
- 3 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 4 publication in the statute book.
