AN ACT concerning health and health care; prescribing disclosure and availability of quality and performance indicators by certain health care providers for health or medical care services.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Each health care provider shall make available for public disclosure of the health care provider's quality and performance indicators for certain and common health or medical care services.

- (b) This public disclosure of the health care provider's quality and performance data:
- (1) Shall include, but are not limited to: (a) Patient admission and discharge data; (b) hospital emergency department data; (c) surgical outcomes date; (d) data on hospital acquired infections; (e) data on surgical complications; and (f) data on readmissions;
- (2) information about specific surgeries and procedures shall include, but is not limited to: Appendectomy, atrial fibrillation, back and neck surgery without spinal fusion, back and neck surgery with spinal fusion, bowel obstruction, carotid endarterectomy, cancer, cholecystectomy, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), community acquired pneumonia, coronary bypass surgery, coronary interventional procedures, diabetic acidosis and coma, drug therapies and interactions, gastrointestinal bleed, gastrointestinal procedures and surgeries, heart attack, heart failure, hip fracture repair, maternity care, pancreatitis, partial hip replacement, peripheral vascular bypass, prostatectomy, pulmonary embolism, resection/replacement of abdominal aorta, respiratory failure, sepsis, stroke, total hip replacement, total knee replacement, valve replacement surgery; and
- (3) a copy of the requested indicator/outcome shall be given to any consumer upon request.
- (c) As used in this section, (1) "health care or medical care services" includes all health or medical care, services, procedures, surgeries and drugs; and (2) "health care provider" includes general and specialty hospitals, outpatient medical treatment facilities, outpatient ambulatory surgical centers and emergency rooms.
 - (d) This section shall be known and may be cited as the health care

- quality and performance act.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
