9 AN ACT concerning crimes, criminal procedure and punishment; pro-10 hibiting unlawful advertising of proprietary material.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful advertising of proprietary material for any person to market, display, advertise for sale, offer to sell or offer to resell any ticket of admission to a public event utilizing any words, terms, symbols, names, devices, means or rights that are proprietary to the sponsor of the public event, including, but not limited to, any trademarks, service marks, trade names, trade dress, logos or graphics, unless such person:

- Has obtained the consent of the sponsor of the public event;
- disclaims any affiliation with, association with, or connection to the sponsor of the public event as part of the marketing, display, advertisement, or offer; or
- only undertakes such action after the public event has concluded or the time for such public event has passed.
  - As used in this section:
- "Person" means any individual, firm, corporation, partnership, limited liability partnership or other business entity;
- "public event" means any musical or theatrical performance, concert, exhibition or sporting athletic contest open to the general public; and
- (3)"ticket" means any printed or electronic medium of admission or right of entry to a public event.
- A person convicted of violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a class A nonperson misdemeanor.
- (d) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas criminal code.
- This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
