HOUSE BILL No. 2327

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9 AN ACT establishing the applied behavioral science training program; 10 prescribing guidelines and limitations therefor; authorizing certain 11loans and agreements thereunder. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. (a) There is hereby established the applied behavioral sci-15ence training program at the college of liberal arts and sciences at the 16university of Kansas which shall be developed and implemented in order 17to provide encouragement, opportunities and incentives for persons pur-18suing a master's of arts in applied behavioral science degree program with 19an emphasis in autism spectrum disorders at the university of Kansas to 20locate their practice of behavior analysis in the state board of education 21member districts throughout Kansas to meet the needs of children with 22 autism spectrum disorders in the state of Kansas. The program shall be 23 administered by the college of liberal arts and sciences of the university 24 of Kansas. 25Subject to the provisions of appropriation acts, in accordance with (b) 26the provisions of this section, the college may enter into program agree-27 ments with up to five first-year master's of arts students per year in ap-28plied behavioral science with an emphasis in autism spectrum disorders. 29 Preference shall be given to those students who are Kansas residents, 30 who agree to work with children with autism spectrum disorders and who 31agree to serve in a state board of education member district as described 32 in subsection (d)(3) as determined by the college. The college shall de-33 termine the state board of education member district to which students 34 shall be designated based upon an equitable distribution of services to 35 families with children one and one-half to eight years of age who have 36 autism spectrum disorder. No state board of education member district 37 shall have a subsequent student designated to such district until each 38 individual state board of education member district has one student designated to it. 39 40 Subject to the provisions of appropriation acts, each student en-(c) 41tering into a program agreement under this section shall receive a loan

tering into a program agreement under this section shan receive a loan
 in the amount of \$20,000 per year for not more than three years for
 tuition, books, supplies and other school expenses, and travel and training

expenses incurred by the student in pursuing a master's of arts degree in applied behavioral science with an emphasis of behavior analysis of children with autism spectrum disorder. Upon satisfaction of all commitments under the provisions of the agreement and the provisions of this section, the loans provided pursuant to this section shall be deemed satisfied and forgiven.

7 (d) Each program agreement shall require that the person receiving 8 the loan:

9 (1) Complete the master's of arts degree program in applied behav-10 ioral science in the college;

(2) complete all advanced training required to be certified as an applied behavior analyst with a special emphasis in autism spectrum disorders as required by the college;

engage in the full-time practice of applied behavior analysis of 14(3)15 children with autism spectrum disorders in the state board of education 16member district designated by the college at the time the person entered into the program agreement for a period of at least 12 continuous months 1718for each separate year a student receives a loan under the program, unless 19such obligation is otherwise satisfied as provided in this section. A pro-20gram agreement whereby the person pursuant to such agreement is en-21gaging in the full-time practice of applied behavior analysis in a state 22 board of education member district that no longer requires the services 23 of such analyst after the date that such program agreement was entered into by the college and the person shall continue in full force and effect 24 25subject to the other requirements contained in this section;

(4) commence such full-time practice of applied behavior analysis of
children with autism spectrum disorders within 90 days after completion
of such person's degree program, or if such person enters a post-degree
training program such as a graduate school or internship or residency
program, within 90 days after completion of such post-degree training
program;

(5) become certified as a behavior analyst by the behavior analysis certification board within one year after completion of such person's degree program, or if such person enters a post-degree training program such as a graduate school or internship or residency program, within 90 days after completion of such post-degree training program; and

(6) upon failure to satisfy the obligation to engage in the full-time practice of applied behavior analysis of children with autism spectrum disorders in accordance with the provisions of this section, repay to the college, within 90 days of such failure, the amount equal to the amount loaned to such person less a prorated amount based on any such periods of practice of applied behavior analysis of children with autism spectrum disorders meeting the requirements of this section, plus interest at the prime rate of interest plus 2% from the date such loan accrued. Such
 interest shall be compounded annually.

3 (e) An obligation to engage in the practice of applied behavior analysis of children with autism spectrum disorders in accordance with the 4 provisions of this section shall be postponed during: (1) Any period of $\mathbf{5}$ temporary medical disability during which the person obligated is unable 6 7 to practice applied behavior analysis of children with autism spectrum 8 disorders due to such disability; and (2) any other period of postponement 9 agreed to or determined in accordance with criteria agreed to in the practice agreement. 10

(f) An obligation to engage in the practice of applied behavior analysis 11 12of children with autism spectrum disorders in accordance with the pro-13 visions of the agreement and this section shall be satisfied: (1) If the obligation to engage in the practice of applied behavior analysis of chil-1415 dren with autism spectrum disorders in accordance with the agreement 16has been completed; (2) if, because of permanent disability, the person obligated is unable to practice applied behavior analysis of children with 1718autism spectrum disorders; or (3) the person obligated dies.

(g) The college may adopt additional provisions, requirements or conditions to participate in this program as are practicable and appropriate to accomplish the provisions of the program or may be required for the implementation or administration of the program, and, in any case, as are not inconsistent with the provisions of this section or the provisions of appropriation acts.

25(h) As used in this section: (1) "Autism spectrum disorder(s)" means 26autism, Asperger's syndrome, pervasive developmental disorder and per-27vasive developmental disorder, not otherwise specified; (2) "college" means the college of liberal arts and sciences at the university of Kansas; 2829 (3) "program" means the training program in applied behavioral science 30 established pursuant to this section; and (4) "program agreement" means an agreement to meet all the obligations provided in this section by a 3132 person who is a first-year master's of arts student in applied behavioral 33 science in the college, and provides benefits to such person as provided 34 in this section.

(i) The college shall not enter into any program agreements pursuant
to the provisions of this section after July 1, 2017. All program agreements
entered into prior to such date shall continue in full force and effect
subject to the requirements of this section.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
