9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas highway patrol; amending K.S.A. 74-10 2113 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 74-2113 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-142113. (a) There is hereby created a Kansas highway patrol. The patrol 15 shall consist of: (1) A superintendent, who shall have the rank of colonel 16and who shall have special training and qualifications for such position; 17(2) an assistant superintendent, who shall have the rank of lieutenant 18colonel; and (3) officers and troopers who are appointed in accordance 19with appropriation acts and as provided in this section. The superinten-20dent and assistant superintendent shall be within the unclassified service 21under the Kansas civil service act. The assistant superintendent serving 22 on the effective date of this act shall be appointed to such position by the 23 superintendent. Thereafter, the assistant superintendent shall be ap-24 pointed by the superintendent from among the members of the patrol, 25and shall serve at the pleasure of the superintendent. If a person ap-26pointed as superintendent or assistant superintendent is a member of the 27 patrol when appointed, such person in each case, upon termination of the 28term as superintendent or assistant superintendent, respectively, shall be 29 returned to a rank not lower than the rank such person held when ap-30 pointed as superintendent or assistant superintendent. If such rank is 31 filled at that time, a temporary additional position shall be created in such 32 rank until a vacancy occurs in such rank. All other officers, troopers and 33 employees shall be within the classified service under the Kansas civil 34 service act. 35 The superintendent of the patrol shall be appointed by the gov-(b) 36 ernor, subject to confirmation by the senate as provided in K.S.A. 75-37 4315b, and amendments thereto, and shall receive an annual salary fixed 38 by the governor. The assistant superintendent shall receive an annual 39 salary fixed by the superintendent and approved by the governor. 40 All other members of the patrol shall be appointed by the super-(c) 41intendent in accordance with appropriation acts and with the Kansas civil 42service act. No person shall be appointed as an officer of the patrol, other 43 than superintendent, unless the person has had at least five years of serv4

1 ice in the patrol as an officer or trooper. No person shall be appointed as

a trooper unless the person meets the following requirements: 2 3

(1) Is a citizen of the United States;

(2)is at least 21 years of age at the time of appointment;

(3) has not been convicted by any state or the federal government of 5a crime which is a felony or its equivalent under the uniform code of 6 7 military justice;

8 (4) has been fingerprinted and a search of local, state and national fingerprint files has been made to determine whether the applicant has 9 a criminal record; 10

(5) is the holder of a high school diploma or furnishes evidence of 11 12successful completion of an examination indicating an equivalent achieve-13 ment: and

is free of any physical or mental condition which might adversely 14(6)15affect the applicant's performance of duties as a trooper and whose phys-16 ical health has been certified by an examining physician appointed by the 17superintendent.

18(d) No member of the patrol shall hold any other elective or appoint-19ive commission or office, except in the Kansas national guard or in the 20organized reserve of the United States army, air force or navy. No mem-21ber of the patrol shall accept any employment or compensation from any 22 licensee of the director of alcoholic beverage control of the department 23 of revenue or from any licensee of the Kansas racing commission or from any officer, director, member or employee of any such licensee, nor shall 24 any member of the patrol accept any employment or compensation for 2526services which require the use of any state-owned equipment provided 27 by the Kansas highway patrol or the wearing of the patrol uniform. No member of the patrol shall accept any reward or gift except with the 2829 written permission of the superintendent. 30

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-2113 is hereby repealed.
