9 AN ACT concerning law enforcement; relating to the enforcement of immigration laws.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. All state and local law enforcement officers shall inquire into the citizenship or immigration status of any person detained for a violation of state law or city ordinance or county resolution. The inquiry may not significantly expand the duration of the detention. In all cases where a person is found not to be lawfully present in the United States, the law enforcement agency shall notify the appropriate federal immigration authority and detain the person if so requested by such authorities.

- Sec. 2. (a) The governing body of any city or county shall not adopt any ordinance or resolution which prohibits or restricts law enforcement agencies from inquiring into the citizenship or immigration status of persons detained for violations of state law, city ordinances or county resolutions.
- (b) No state or local law enforcement agency shall adopt any policy which prohibits or restricts a law enforcement officer's ability to inquire into the citizenship or immigration status of persons detained for violations of state law, city ordinances or county resolutions.
- Sec. 3. The attorney general shall enter into a cooperation agreement with the United States department of homeland security to designate specific law enforcement officers as officers qualified to exercise enforcement powers of federal immigration officers pursuant to subsection 1357(g) of title 8, of the United States code.
- Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
