AN ACT relating to certain life form engineering; concerning animalhuman hybrid; creating certain crimes and providing penalties for such crimes; authorizing civil fines.

18 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) As used in this section:

- (1) "Animal-human hybrid" means:
- (A) A human embryo into which a nonhuman cell or cells (or the component parts thereof) have been introduced to render its membership in the species homo sapiens uncertain through germline or other changes;
- (B) a hybrid human or animal, or both, embryo produced by fertilizing a human egg with nonhuman sperm;
- (C) a hybrid human or animal, or both, embryo produced by fertilizing a nonhuman egg with human sperm;
- (D) an embryo produced by introducing a nonhuman nucleus into a human egg;
- (E) an embryo produced by introducing a human nucleus into a non-human egg;
- (F) an embryo containing haploid sets of chromosomes from both a human and a nonhuman life form;
- (G) a nonhuman life form engineered such that human gametes develop within the body of a nonhuman life form; or
- (H) a nonhuman life form engineered such that it contains a human brain or a brain derived wholly or predominantly from human neural tissues.
- (2) "Human embryo" means (1) The developing organism of the species homo sapiens from the time of fertilization until significant differentiation has occurred, when the organism becomes known as fetus; or (2) an organism of the species homo sapiens in the earliest stages of development.

- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly:
  - Create or attempt to create an animal-human hybrid;
- 3 (2)transfer or attempt to transfer a human embryo into a nonhuman 4 womb;
- 5 (3)transfer or attempt to transfer a nonhuman embryo into a human 6 womb; or
  - transport or receive for any purpose an animal-human hybrid.
- Any person who violates subsection (b) shall be guilty of a severity 9 level 3, person felony.
- (d) Any person who violates subsection (b) and derives pecuniary gain 10 from such violation shall be subject to a civil fine of the greater of 11 \$1,000,000 and an amount equal to the amount of the gross gain multi-12 13 plied by two. Moneys collected pursuant to this subsection shall be deposited in the state general fund. 14
- 15 (e) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas crim-16 inal code.
- 17 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 18 publication in the statute book.
