12AN ACT concerning elections; relating to campaign finance; amending 13 K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 25-4148 and repealing the existing section. 1415Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 16K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 25-4148 is hereby amended to read Section 1. as follows: 25-4148. (a) (1) Every treasurer shall file a report preseribed 17by this section. Reports filed by treasurers for candidates for state office, 1819other than officers elected on a state-wide basis, shall be filed in both the 20office of the secretary of state and in the office of the county election 21officer of the county in which the candidate is a resident. Reports filed 22by treasurers for candidates for state-wide office shall be filed only with 23 the secretary of state. Reports filed by treasurers for candidates for local 24 office shall be filed in the office of the county election officer of the county 25in which the name of the candidate is on the ballot. 26(2) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (h), all such reports 27 shall be filed in time to be received in the offices required on or before 28each of the following days: 29 (1) (A) The eighth day preceding the primary election, which. Such 30 report shall be for the period beginning on January 1 of the election year 31for the office the candidate is seeking and ending 12 days before the 32 primary election, inclusive;. 33 (2) (B) The eighth day preceding a general election, which. Such 34 report shall be for the period beginning 11 days before the primary elee-35 tion and ending 12 4 12 days before the general election, inclusive;. 36 (3) (C) January 10 of the year after an election year, which. Such 37 report shall be for the period beginning 11 days before the general elee-38 tion and ending on December 31, inclusive;. 39 -(4) (D) For any calendar year when no election is held, a report shall 40 be filed on the next January 10 for the preceding calendar year; 41(5) A treasurer shall file only the annual report required by subsection 42(4) this subparagraph only for those years when the candidate is not 43 participating in a primary or general election.

The report shall show 35 in detail the specific service or product provided; and 36 (B) the name and address of each candidate for state or local office 37 who is the subject of an expenditure which: 38 -(i) Is made without the cooperation or consent of a candidate or can-39 didate committee; 40 (ii) expressly advocates the nomination, election or defeat of such can-41didate: and 42(iii) is an aggregate amount or having a fair market value in excess

43 of \$300.

The report 28shall show in detail the specific service or product provided. The 29 reporting requirements imposed by this subsection shall be in ad-30 dition to all other requirements required by this section. 31 (e) (d) Treasurers of candidates and of candidate committees shall be 32 required to itemize, as provided in subsection (b)(2), only itemize the 33 purchase of tickets or admissions to testimonial events by a person 34 who purchases such tickets or admissions in an aggregate amount 35 or value in excess of \$50 per event, or who purchases such a ticket 36 or admission at a cost exceeding \$25 per ticket or admission. All 37 other purchases of tickets or admissions to testimonial events shall 38 be reported in an aggregate amount and shall not be subject to 39 the limitations specified in K.S.A. 25-4154, and amendments 40 thereto. - (d) (c) If a contribution or other receipt from a political committee 4142is required to be reported under subsection (b), the report shall include

If the committee is not connected or affiliated with any one organization, the report shall state the trade, profession or primary interest 4 $\mathbf{5}$ of the political committee as reflected by the statement of purpose of 6 such organization. 7 - (c) (f) The commission may require any treasurer to file an amended 8 report for any period for which the original report filed by such treasurer 9 contains material errors or omissions, and. The notice of the errors or omissions shall be part of the public record. The amended report shall 10be filed within 30 days after notice by the commission. 11 12-(f) (g) The commission may require any treasurer to file a report for any period for which the required report is not on file, and. The notice 13 14of the failure to file shall be part of the public record. notice of the errors or omissions shall be part of the public record.
The amended report shall be filed within 30 days after notice by
