10 AN ACT concerning campaign finance; relating to filing of certain
11 reports.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. (a) Every treasurer for a candidate for a contested state
15 or local office shall file reports of campaign contributions, **except for**
16 **contributions made by a candidate to such candidate's own cam-**
17 **campaign**, as prescribed by this act. Reports filed by treasurers for candidates
18 for a contested state office, other than officers elected on a state-wide
19 basis, shall be filed in both the office of the secretary of state and in the
20 office of the county election officer of the county in which the candidate
21 is a resident. Reports filed by treasurers for candidates for state-wide
22 office shall be filed only with the secretary of state. Reports filed by
23 treasurers for candidates for local office shall be filed in the office of the
24 county election officer of the county in which the name of the candidate
25 is on the ballot. Reports required by this section shall be in addition to
26 any other reports required by law.

27 (b) The report shall contain the name and address of each person
28 who has made one or more contributions in an aggregate amount or value
29 of \$300 or more during the period commencing 11 days before a primary
30 or general election at which a state or local officer is to be elected and
31 ending at 11:59 p.m. on the ~~Thursday~~ **Wednesday** preceding the date of
32 election. The report shall be made on or before the close of business on
33 the ~~Friday~~ **Thursday** preceding the day of election. The report shall
34 contain the amount and date of the contribution, including the name and
35 address of every lender, guarantor and endorser when the contribution
36 is in the form of an advance or loan. The report shall be made on or
37 before the close of the next business day, the ~~Friday~~ **Thursday** preceding
38 the date of such election.

39 (c) Reports required by this section shall be filed by electronic mail,
40 facsimile transmission, telegram or by any express delivery service.

41 (d) (1) "Local office" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A.
42 25-4143 and amendments thereto.

43 (2) "State office" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A. 25-

1 4143 and amendments thereto.

2 (e) The provisions of this section shall be part of and supplemental
3 to the campaign finance act.

4 (f) Any report required by this section may be signed by the candidate
5 in lieu of the candidate's treasurer or the treasurer of the candidate's
6 committee.

7 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
8 publication in the statute book.
