9 AN ACT relating to veterans; enacting the Kansas returning heroes' education act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. Sections 1 through 6 shall be known and may be cited as the Kansas returning heroes' education act. It is the purpose of the Kansas returning heroes' education act to establish an educational assistance program under which payment of the tuition and fees charged eligible honorably discharged members of the United States armed forces and citizens of the state of Kansas for enrollment at Kansas educational institutions shall be provided for by the state.

- Sec. 2. As used in the Kansas returning heroes' education act:
- (a) "Kansas educational institution" means and includes area vocational schools, area vocational-technical schools, community colleges, municipal universities, state educational institutions, technical colleges and accredited independent institutions.
- (b) "Eligible veteran" means a member of the United States armed forces honorably discharged on or after September 11, 2001: (1) Who is either a domiciliary resident as defined by K.S.A. 76-729, and amendments thereto, or is a graduate from a Kansas high school; (2) who did not serve more than 10 years of active duty; and (3) who is enrolled at a Kansas educational institution. The term eligible veteran does not include within its meaning any veteran who is the holder of a baccalaureate or higher academic degree or who does not hold a high school diploma or general educational development (GED) credentials.
- (c) "Kansas veterans' educational assistance program" or "program" means the program established pursuant to the provisions of the Kansas returning heroes' education act.
- (d) "Educational program" means a program which is offered and maintained by a Kansas educational institution and leads to the award of a certificate, diploma or degree upon satisfactory completion of coursework requirements.
- Sec. 3. The state board of regents shall adopt rules and regulations for administration of the Kansas returning heroes' education act and shall:
- (a) Establish a mechanism to ensure distribution of funds for tuition

and fee reimbursement to Kansas educational institutions;

- (b) enter into a cooperative relationship with the Kansas commission on veterans' affairs to ensure efficient operation of the program;
- (c) develop and effectuate a system of accountability for all disbursements under the program and provide written reports as prescribed; and
- (d) coordinate with the Kansas commission on veterans affairs a procedure to ensure initial and on-going eligibility of all eligible veterans who are program participants.
- Sec. 4. (a) Subject to the availability of appropriations for the Kansas veterans' educational assistance program and within the limits of any such appropriations, every eligible veteran who is enrolled at a Kansas educational institution and who is participating in the program shall be paid the amount of tuition and required fees charged by the Kansas educational institution for enrollment in courses necessary to satisfy the requirements of an educational program.
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), eligible veterans shall not be paid the amount of tuition and required fees charged for any course repeated or taken in excess of the requirements for completion of the educational program in which the eligible veteran is enrolled. The amount of tuition and required fees paid an eligible veteran pursuant to subsection (a) shall be at a rate not to exceed the maximum rate that would be charged by the state educational institutions for enrollment of the eligible veteran.
- Sec. 5. (a) In order to remain eligible for participation in the program, an eligible veteran must remain in good standing at the Kansas educational institution where enrolled and make satisfactory progress toward completion of the requirements of the educational program in which enrolled.
- (b) Upon failure of any person, who as an eligible veteran received payments under the Kansas returning heroes' education act, to satisfy the qualifications of subsection (a), such person shall pay to the state of Kansas an amount equal to the total amount received. All amounts paid to the state under this subsection shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the Kansas veterans' educational assistance program repayment fund created by section 6, and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 6. There is hereby created in the state treasury the Kansas veterans' educational assistance program repayment fund. The state board of regents shall remit all moneys received under section 5, and amendments thereto, to the state treasurer at least monthly. Upon receipt of each such remittance the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount thereof in the state treasury, and such amount shall be credited to the Kansas veterans' educational assistance program repayment fund. All expenditures from the Kansas veterans' educational assistance program re-

- payment fund shall be for payments of assistance under the Kansas returning heroes' education act, and shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the executive officer of the state board of regents or a person designated by the executive officer.
