9 AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to teachers' contracts; 10amending K.S.A. 72-5411 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 72-5411 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-14 5411. (a) All contracts of employment of teachers in the public schools 15 in the state shall continue in full force and effect during good behavior 16 and efficient and competent service rendered by the teacher, and all 17contracts of employment shall be deemed to continue for the next suc-18ceeding school year unless written notice of intention to terminate a con-19tract of employment is served by a board of education upon any teacher 20on or before May 1. A teacher shall give written notice to the board of 21education of a school district that the teacher does not desire continuation 22 of a contract of employment on or before May 15 31 or, if applicable, not 23 later than 15 days after final action is taken by the board of education 24 upon termination of professional negotiation absent a binding agreement 25under article 54 of chapter 72 of Kansas Statutes Annotated, whichever 26is the later date. 27 Terms of a contract may be changed at any time by mutual con-(b) 28 sent of both a teacher and the board of education of a school district. 29 Sec. 2.
