9 AN ACT concerning crimes, criminal procedure and punishment; relating to unlawful hosting of minors; amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 21-10 3610c and repealing the existing section. 11 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 21-3610c is hereby amended to read 15as follows: 21-3610c. (a) Unlawfully hosting minors consuming alcoholic 16 liquor or cereal malt beverage is intentionally permitting a person's res-17idence or any land, building, structure or room owned, occupied or pro-18cured by such person to be used by an invitee of such person or an invitee 19of such person's child or ward, in a manner that results in the possession 20or consumption therein of alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverages by 21persons under the age of 18 any minors. 22 (b) Unlawfully hosting minors consuming alcoholic liquor or cereal 23 malt beverage is a class A person misdemeanor, for which the minimum 24 fine is \$1,000. If the court sentences the offender to perform community 25or public service work as a condition of probation, as described in sub-26 section (c)(10) of K.S.A. 21-4610, and amendments thereto, the court 27 shall consider ordering the offender to serve the community or public 28service at an alcohol treatment facility. 29 (c) As used in this section, terms have the meanings provided by 30 K.S.A. 41-102, and amendments thereto, except for the purposes of this 31 section, "minor" means a person under the age of 18. 32 (d) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the Kansas 33 criminal code. 34 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 21-3610c is hereby repealed. 35 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 36 publication in the statute book.
