9 AN ACT concerning crimes, criminal procedure and punishment; relat-
10 ing to unlawful hosting of minors; amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 21-
11 3610c and repealing the existing section.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 21-3610c is hereby amended to read
15 as follows: 21-3610c. (a) Unlawfully hosting minors consuming alcoholic
16 liquor or cereal malt beverage is intentionally permitting a person's res-
17 idence or any land, building, structure or room owned, occupied or pro-
18 cured by such person to be used by an invitee of such person or an invitee
19 of such person's child or ward, in a manner that results in the possession
20 or consumption therein of alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverages by
21 ~~persons under the age of 18~~ *any minors*.

22 (b) Unlawfully hosting minors consuming alcoholic liquor or cereal
23 malt beverage is a class A person misdemeanor, for which the minimum
24 fine is \$1,000. If the court sentences the offender to perform community
25 or public service work as a condition of probation, as described in sub-
26 section (c)(10) of K.S.A. 21-4610, and amendments thereto, the court
27 shall consider ordering the offender to serve the community or public
28 service at an alcohol treatment facility.

29 (c) As used in this section, terms have the meanings provided by
30 K.S.A. 41-102, and amendments thereto, ~~except for the purposes of this~~
31 ~~section, "minor" means a person under the age of 18.~~

32 (d) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the Kansas
33 criminal code.

34 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 21-3610c is hereby repealed.
