9 AN ACT concerning the secretary of wildlife and parks; relating to fees 10 for resident and nonresident deer permits; feed the hungry fund; 11 amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 32-988 and repealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 32-988 is hereby amended to read as 15 follows: 32-988. - 7 (b) The fee for a landowner-tenant resident big game or wild turkey 8 hunting permit shall be an amount equal to ½ the fee for a general resident big game or wild turkey hunting permit.
- 10 (c) The fee for a furharvester license for a resident under 16 years of 11 age shall be an amount equal to ½ the fee for a resident furharvester 12 license.
 - (d) The fee for every resident and nonresident deer permit shall be increased by the amount of \$1, and such amount shall be deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the feed the hungry fund pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 32-995, and amendments thereto. The secretary shall certify to the state treasurer the amount to be credited to the feed the hungry fund pursuant to this subsection.
 - (d) (e) The secretary may establish, by rules and regulations adopted in accordance with K.S.A. 32-805 and amendments thereto, different fees for various classes and types of licenses, permits, stamps and other issuances of the department which may occur within each item as described under subsection (a).
- 24 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 32-988 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
