

## HOUSE BILL No. 2498

9 AN ACT concerning the secretary of wildlife and parks; relating to fees  
10 for resident and nonresident deer permits; feed the hungry fund;  
11 amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 32-988 and repealing the existing section.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 32-988 is hereby amended to read as  
15 follows: 32-988. (a) The secretary is authorized to adopt, in accordance  
16 with K.S.A. 32-805 and amendments thereto, rules and regulations fixing  
17 the amount of fees for the following items, subject to the following lim-  
18 itations and subject to the requirement that no such rules and regulations  
19 shall be adopted as temporary rules and regulations:

20 Big game permits

21 Resident (other than elk permit): maximum \$100

22 Nonresident (other than elk permit): maximum \$400

23 Elk permit: maximum \$350

24 Resident big game tag: maximum \$20

25 Nonresident big game tag: maximum \$30

26 Nonresident applications: maximum \$25

27 Combination hunting and fishing licenses

28 Resident: maximum \$50

29 Lifetime: maximum \$1,000; or 8 quarterly payments, each maximum \$150

30 Nonresident: maximum \$200

31 Commercial dog training permits: maximum \$25

32 Commercial guide permit or associate guide permit

33 Resident: maximum \$250

34 Nonresident: maximum \$1,000

35 Commercial harvest or dealer permits: maximum \$200

36 Commercial prairie rattlesnake harvesting permits

37 Resident or nonresident with valid hunting license: maximum \$5

38 Resident or nonresident nonfirearm without valid hunting license: maximum \$20

39 Controlled shooting area operator license: maximum \$400

40 Duplicate licenses, permits, stamps and other issues of the department: maximum \$10

41 Falconry

42 Permits: maximum \$300

43 Examinations: maximum \$100

- 27 Migratory waterfowl habitat stamps: maximum \$8

3 Special events on department land or water: maximum \$200  
4 Special departmental services, materials or supplies: no maximum  
5 Other issues of department: no maximum  
6 Vendor bond: no maximum  
7 (b) The fee for a landowner-tenant resident big game or wild turkey  
8 hunting permit shall be an amount equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a general res-  
9 ident big game or wild turkey hunting permit.  
10 (c) The fee for a furharvester license for a resident under 16 years of  
11 age shall be an amount equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  the fee for a resident furharvester  
12 license.  
13 *(d) The fee for every resident and nonresident deer permit shall be*  
14 *increased by the amount of \$1, and such amount shall be deposited in the*  
15 *state treasury to the credit of the feed the hungry fund pursuant to the*  
16 *provisions of K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 32-995, and amendments thereto. The*  
17 *secretary shall certify to the state treasurer the amount to be credited to*  
18 *the feed the hungry fund pursuant to this subsection.*  
19 ~~(e)~~ (e) The secretary may establish, by rules and regulations adopted  
20 in accordance with K.S.A. 32-805 and amendments thereto, different fees  
21 for various classes and types of licenses, permits, stamps and other issu-  
22 ances of the department which may occur within each item as described  
23 under subsection (a).  
24 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 32-988 is hereby repealed.  
25 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
26 publication in the statute book.
