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9 AN ACT concerning the county business restoration assistance program; 10 amending K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 75-3713e and repealing the existing section. 1112 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 75-3713e is hereby amended to read 15as follows: 75-3713e. (a) There is hereby established the county business 16 restoration assistance program which shall be implemented and admin-17istered by the secretary of revenue in accordance with this section. The 18program is established for the purpose of assisting businesses that were 19in operation in a county which was struck by the tornado and other severe weather in Kansas on May 4, 2007, which had damage and destruction 2021to governmental buildings and facilities to the extent that there was a 22 complete interruption of all governmental services provided by a major 23 town and the county government, and which suffered a major loss of the 24 property tax base for the county of 25% or more, and that were damaged 25by such tornado and other severe storms on May 4, 2007, to rebuild 26business facilities, to acquire business machinery and equipment, and to 27reestablish jobs in such county for such businesses. 28(b) The assistance payments under the program shall be available 29 only for qualifying businesses as defined by this section. The program 30 shall provide investment assistance payments and job restoration assis-31tance payments that are applied for during the period commencing on 32 the effective date of this act through June 30, 2008 2009. 33 (c) Each investment assistance payment shall be an amount of not 34 more than 10% of a qualifying investment made to rebuild or replace the 35 building or structure or to replace the business machinery and equipment 36 in the county. In accordance with policies adopted by the secretary of 37 revenue, the investment assistance payment shall be for the purpose of 38 assisting the business recover from the damage sustained from the storm 39 on May 4, 2007. To be a qualifying investment under this program, the 40 investment must be made between May 4, 2007, and June 30, 2008 2009. 41Each job restoration assistance payment shall be an amount of (d) 42not more than \$3,500 per full-time-equivalent job for an employee the 43 applicant business hires back in the county. In accordance with policies 4

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adopted by the secretary of revenue, the job restoration assistance pay ment shall be for the purpose of assisting the business recover from the
damages sustained from the storm on May 4, 2007.

(e) As used in this section:

5 (1) "Business facility" means a building or structure used in business 6 operations located within the county;

7 (2) "business machinery and equipment" means the real and tangible 8 personal property permanently and physically located at a business facility 9 and used in the business operations and shall not include (A) mobile 10 equipment, such as motor vehicles, or (B) any items held for sale, such 11 as business inventory;

12(3)"qualifying business" means a business that was in existence and 13 in operation providing goods or services within a county, which was struck by the tornado and other severe weather in Kansas on May 4, 2007, which 1415 had damage and destruction to governmental buildings and facilities to 16the extent that there was a complete interruption of all governmental services provided by a major town and the county government, and which 1718suffered a major loss of the property tax base for the county of 25% or more, and that was damaged by the tornado and other severe storms that 1920struck Kansas on May 4, 2007; and

(4) "qualifying job" means a job with a qualifying business that was lost as a result of damage sustained by the tornado and other severe storms that struck Kansas on May 4, 2007, that is restored and filled by an employee hired back in the county between May 4, 2007, and June 30, 2008 2009, and shall not include any part-time job that provides the employee with less than 20 hours per week of paid employment.

27 (f) In accordance with the provisions of this section, the secretary of 28revenue shall adopt policies and procedures for the implementation and 29 administration of the county business restoration assistance program and 30 shall present such information to the state finance council requesting 31 approval to make expenditures from the state emergency fund for assis-32 tance payments under the program in accordance with the proposed im-33 plementation and administration of the program. Upon approval of the 34 state finance council by the affirmative vote of the governor and by a 35 majority vote of the legislative members of the state finance council, act-36 ing on this matter which is hereby characterized as a matter of legislative 37 delegation and subject to the guidelines prescribed in subsection (c) of 38 K.S.A. 75-3711c, and amendments thereto, and subject to the limitation 39 that not more than \$5,000,000 may be approved by the state finance 40 council to be expended from the state emergency fund for such payments, the director of the budget shall certify to the director of accounts and 41reports the amount approved by the state finance council for expenditure 42

by the department of revenue for such assistance payments from the state

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- emergency fund. 1
