10AN ACT concerning income taxation; relating to credits; property tax 11paid by certain taxpayers. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the selective 15 assistance for effective senior relief (SAFESR). For all taxable years com-16mencing after December 31, 2007, there shall be allowed as a credit 17against the tax liability of a taxpayer imposed under the Kansas income 18tax act, an amount equal to 75% of the amount of property and ad valorem 19taxes actually and timely paid by a taxpayer who is 65 years of age or older 20and who has household income equal to or less than 120% of the federal 21poverty level for two persons if such taxes were paid upon real or personal 22property used for residential purposes of such taxpayer which is the tax-23 payer's principal place of residence for the tax year in which the tax credit 24 is claimed. The amount of any such credit for any such taxpayer shall not 25exceed the amount of property and ad valorem taxes paid by such taxpayer 26 as specified in this section. A taxpayer shall not take the credit pursuant 27 to this section if such taxpayer has received a homestead property tax 28refund pursuant to K.S.A. 79-4501 et seq., and amendments thereto, for 29 such property for such tax year. Subject to the provisions of this section, 30 if the amount of such tax credit exceeds the taxpayer's income tax liability 31 for the taxable year, the amount of such excess credit which exceeds such 32 tax liability shall be refunded to the taxpayer. The secretary of revenue 33 shall adopt rules and regulations regarding the filing of documents that 34 support the amount of the credit claimed pursuant to this section. For 35 purposes of this section, "household income" means all income, including 36 payments received under the federal social security act, received by per-37 sons of a household in a calendar year while members of such household. 38 [The provisions of this act shall be part of and supplemental to the 39 homestead property tax refund act.] 40 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 41publication in the statute book.
