10 AN ACT concerning consumer protection; relating to health care providers; amending K.S.A. 50-635 and repealing the existing section.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 50-635 is hereby amended to read as follows: 50-635. (a) The Kansas consumer protection act does not apply to a publisher, broadcaster, printer or other person engaged in the dissemination of information or the reproduction of printed or pictorial matter so far as the information or matter has been disseminated or reproduced on behalf of others without actual knowledge that it violated the Kansas consumer protection act.

- (b) The Kansas consumer protection act does not apply to the rendering of or failure to render professional services by a physician or other health care provider with respect to professional services for which such physician or health care provider is licensed or regulated by the state of Kansas. For the purposes of this section, "professional services" means any service, treatment, operation, prescription, communication or practice related to the care, treatment, diagnosis, ascertainment, cure, relief, palliation, adjustment, or correction of any disease, condition, ailment, deformity, or injury. "Professional services" does not include billing, advertising or other business services.
- (c) A supplier alleged to have violated this act has the burden of showing the applicability of this section.
 - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 50-635 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
