AN ACT concerning the department on aging; relating to fees for licenses to operate adult care homes; disposition of such fees; creation and administration of the state licensure fee fund; amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 39-930 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 39-930 is hereby amended to read as follows: 39-930. (a) The fee for license to operate an adult care home shall be a base amount plus an additional amount for each bed of such home which shall be paid to the secretary of aging before the license is issued. The fee shall be fixed by rules and regulations of the secretary of aging. The amount received for the license fee shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be credited to the state treasury and which shall be administered by the department on aging.

(b) If the evaluation and inspection was made by a county, city-county or multicounty health department at the direction of the secretary of health and environment aging and the papers required are completed and filed with the secretary, then the amount equal to 40% of the fee collected shall be forwarded paid to such county, city-county or multicounty health department. If a facility has a change of administrator after the commencement of the licensing period, the fee shall be \$15 and shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the state general licensure fee fund. (c) All expenditures from the state licensure fee fund shall be made in

(c) All expenditures from the state licensure fee fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the secretary of aging or by the secretary's designee.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 39-930 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
