(a) The board of nursing may require an *original* appli-16cant for licensure as a professional nurse, practical nurse or mental health technician to be fingerprinted and submit to a state and national criminal 1718history record check. The fingerprints shall be used to identify the applicant and to determine whether the applicant has a record of criminal 1920history in this state or other jurisdictions. The board of nursing is au-21thorized to submit the fingerprints to the Kansas bureau of investigation 22 and the federal bureau of investigation for a state and national criminal 23 history record check. The board of nursing may use the information obtained from fingerprinting and the applicant's criminal history for pur-24 25poses of verifying the identification of any applicant and in the official 26 determination of character and fitness of the applicant for any licensure 27to practice professional or practical nursing or mental health technology in this state. 2829 Local and state law enforcement officers and agencies shall assist (b) 30 the board of nursing in taking and processing of fingerprints of applicants 31to practice professional or practical nursing or mental health technology 32 in this state and shall release all records of adult and juvenile convictions, 33 adjudications, expungements and non-convictions to the board of nursing. 34 (c) The board shall fix a fee for fingerprinting of applicants or licens-35 ees, or both, as may be required by the board in an amount necessary to 36 reimburse the board for the cost of the fingerprinting.
