9 AN ACT concerning traffic infractions; authorizing dismissal of certain traffic infractions and ordinance traffic infractions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, anyone who served in active service since September 11, 2001, in any armed service of the United States of America, and any member of the Kansas army or air national guard in active federal service who is or was in the active military service of the United States of America in an armed conflict in Iraq or Afghanistan who has been charged with violation of a traffic infraction, as defined by K.S.A. 21-3105, and amendments thereto, or an ordinance traffic infraction, as defined in K.S.A. 12-4113, and amendments thereto, which is pending after the effective date of this act shall be eligible to have one pending traffic infraction dismissed on motion of such active service member upon submission of proof of service in the armed forces as prescribed by this subsection to the court. Court costs shall be waived upon dismissal if only one traffic infraction is charged.

- (b) The dismissal authorized by subsection (a) shall not apply to traffic infractions or ordinance traffic infractions in which the judge makes a finding that such infraction occurred in the course of the driver's employment.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
