AN ACT concerning the state corporation commission; relating to providing energy conservation information to consumers by certain electric utilities; establishing the energy conservation education advisory group.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The state corporation commission shall develop and administer a program requiring require all electric public utilities doing business in Kansas to deliver energy education and conservation promotion programs that are consistent with education and conservation standards energy conservation education programs and goals developed by the Kansas energy office of the state corporation commission. The Kansas energy office of the state corporation commission shall, through contracts between the commission and municipalities and electric cooperative utilities, may administer such program for municipal electric utilities and electric cooperative utilities.

- (b) There is hereby created the energy conservation education advisory group for the purpose of developing statewide <u>requirements</u>, <u>standards and guidelines</u> **goals** for the energy education and energy conservation promotion programs pursuant to this section.
- (c) The energy conservation education advisory group shall be appointed by the <u>Kansas energy office</u> **governor** and shall consist of:
 - (1) One member to represent municipal electric utilities;
 - (2) one member to represent electric cooperative utilities;
 - (3) two members to represent investor-owned electric utilities;
 - (4) one member to represent investor-owned natural gas utilities;
- (5) one member to represent municipal natural gas utilities;
- 39 (6) one member who is an employee of the citizens' utility ratepayer 40 board;
- 41 (7) one member who is an employee of Kansas state university in the division of engineering extension;
- 43 (8) one member who is an employee of the Kansas housing resources

- 2 <u>(9) one member to represent the Kansas university transportation</u> 3 center, and
 - <u>(10)</u> two members who are employed by the state corporation commission
 - (8) one member to represent the department of transportation;
 - (9) one member to represent the propane industry;
 - (10) one member to represent the Kansas association for conservation and environmental education;
 - (11) one member to represent the residential construction industry;
 - (12) one member to represent the factory built housing industry;
 - <u>(13) one member to represent the real estate industry;</u>
 - (14) (13) one member who is a certified energy star inspector;
 - (15) (14) one member who represents the mechanical heating, ventilation and air conditioning contractors who have received a certificate of competency for purposes of licensure pursuant to K.S.A. 12-1541, and amendments thereto; and
 - (16) (15) one member who represents agricultural production.
 - (d) (1) The energy conservation education advisory group shall perform such duties as are prescribed by the Kansas energy office to implement the provisions of this section, including prescribing information to be included in program standards. Such duties shall include:
 - (1) Prescribing information to be included in program goals, including, but not limited to:
 - (A) How energy customers can access energy conservation services, such as energy audits throughout the state;
 - (B) financing options for energy conservation improvements;
 - (C) existing state and federal government energy conservation programs, including the Kansas weatherization assistance program and the Kansas energy efficiency program; and
 - (D) performance measures and goals.
 - (2) The energy conservation advisory group shall develop separate energy conservation education curricula Development of separate energy conservation materials for the general public, public school students, local governments, residential, commercial and utility classes and the transportation sector.
 - (3) The energy conservation education advisory group shall recommend (3) Recommendation of mechanisms for recovery of costs of the program by different types of participating utilities.
 - (4) Recommendation of methods of most effectively commu-

nicating with energy consumers.

- (5) Recommendation of performance measures and goals to monitor the effectiveness of the programs authorized pursuant to this section which shall be defined as a percentage of energy consumption. The Kansas energy office of the state corporation commission shall consult with the energy conservation education advisory group before adopting baseline data and goals, data collection methodology and reporting formats.
- (e) On and after July 1, 2008, each electric **public** utility, municipal electric utility and electric cooperative utility doing business in Kansas shall provide such utility's consumers with information concerning energy conservation opportunities and options in accordance with and subject to the <u>standards</u> **goals** prescribed by the energy conservation education advisory group and the Kansas energy office of the state corporation commission, which shall include, but not be limited to:
- (1) Increasing general awareness and understanding of energy conservation opportunities;
- (2) information designed to encourage direct energy consumers to increase their understanding of conservation opportunities specific to such consumer's energy-use type; and
- (3) information on energy conservation measures prescribed in the Kansas energy efficiency disclosure form prepared and disseminated by the state corporation commission pursuant to K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 66-1228, and amendments thereto.
- (f) Electric The Kansas energy office of the state corporation commission and the Kansas energy council, with consultation from electric public utilities, municipal electric utilities and electric cooperative utilities, shall annually submit a written report to the legislature senate committee on utilities and the house committee on energy and utilities, the Kansas energy office of the state corporation commission and the Kansas energy council on or before the beginning of the regular session of the legislature beginning in 2010 2009 on the performance measures and goal outcomes of the energy education and energy conservation promotion programs prescribed by this section.
- (g) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit an electric **public** utility, municipal electric <u>cooperative</u> utility or electric cooperative utility from developing additional energy efficiency and conservation services for sale to consumers on a fee for service basis.
- (h) The regulated utilities shall be expected to pursue cost recovery for development design, development, implementation, promotion, ongoing expenses and evaluation costs of these programs through the normal rate-making process.
