9 AN ACT concerning state governmental ethics; relating to state officers 10 and employees; relating to lobbyists; amending K.S.A. 46-232 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 46-232 is hereby amended to read as follows: 46-15 232. (a) No state officer or employee shall engage in lobbying his such 16 officer's or employee's own state agency, if he such officer or employee accepts compensation specifically attributable to such lobbying, other 1718than that provided for the performance of his such officer's or employee's 19official duties. Nothing in this section shall prohibit a state officer or 20employee from lobbying without compensation other than that which he 21such officer or employee is entitled to receive for performance of his such 22 officer's or employee's official duties. 23 (b) From and after January 1, 2008, no individual shall engage in lobbying or be employed as a lobbyist within two years following: 24 (1) The date of resignation from or the expiration of a term of any 2526 state office to which the individual was appointed by the governor; 27 (2) the date of resignation from or the expiration of a term of office 28in the state legislature to which such individual was elected or appointed; 29 or30 (3) the date of resignation from or the expiration of a term of elected 31state office to which such individual was elected or appointed. 32 (c) For the purposes of this section, the term "elected state office" 33 means the governor, the lieutenant governor, the secretary of state, the 34 attorney general, the commissioner of insurance, the state treasurer and 35 any member of the state board of education. 36 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 46-232 is hereby repealed. 37 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 38 publication in the statute book.
