9 AN ACT concerning state governmental ethics; relating to state officers
10 and employees; relating to lobbyists; amending K.S.A. 46-232 and re-
11 pealing the existing section.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 46-232 is hereby amended to read as follows: 46-
15 232. (a) No state officer or employee shall engage in lobbying ~~his~~ *such*
16 *officer's or employee's* own state agency, if ~~he~~ *such officer or employee*
17 accepts compensation specifically attributable to such lobbying, other
18 than that provided for the performance of ~~his~~ *such officer's or employee's*
19 official duties. Nothing in this section shall prohibit a state officer or
20 employee from lobbying without compensation other than that which ~~he~~
21 *such officer or employee* is entitled to receive for performance of ~~his~~ *such*
22 *officer's or employee's* official duties.

23 (b) *From and after January 1, 2008, no individual shall engage in*
24 *lobbying or be employed as a lobbyist within two years following:*

25 (1) *The date of resignation from or the expiration of a term of any*
26 *state office to which the individual was appointed by the governor;*

27 (2) *the date of resignation from or the expiration of a term of office*
28 *in the state legislature to which such individual was elected or appointed;*
29 *or*

30 (3) *the date of resignation from or the expiration of a term of elected*
31 *state office to which such individual was elected or appointed.*

32 (c) *For the purposes of this section, the term "elected state office"*
33 *means the governor, the lieutenant governor, the secretary of state, the*
34 *attorney general, the commissioner of insurance, the state treasurer and*
35 *any member of the state board of education.*

36 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 46-232 is hereby repealed.

37 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
38 publication in the statute book.
