9 AN ACT concerning the criminal code, creating the crime of deprivation 10of rights under color of law. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. (a) Deprivation of rights under color of law is the inten-13 14tional subjection by a person who, under color of any law, statute, county 15 resolution, ordinance or regulation, of any person, to the deprivation of 16 any rights, privileges or immunities secured or protected by the Consti-17tution or laws of the state of Kansas, or to different punishments, pains 18or penalties on account of such person being an alien, or by reason of 19color or race than are prescribed for the punishment of citizens by: (1)Causing bodily harm to another person or disfigurement of another per-2021son; or (2) causing great bodily harm to another person or disfigurement of 22 23 another person; or 24 causing bodily harm to another person with a deadly weapon, or (3)25in any manner whereby great bodily harm, disfigurement or death can 26be inflicted; or 27 (4) causing physical contact with another person when done in a rude, 28insulting or angry manner with a deadly weapon, or in any manner 29 whereby great bodily harm, disfigurement or death can be inflicted; or 30 causing monetary loss to another person. (5)31 (b) (1) Deprivation of rights under color of law as described in sec-32 tion (a)(1) is a class B person misdemeanor. 33 (2)Deprivation of rights under color of law as defined in subsection 34 (a)(2) is a severity level 4, person felony. 35 Deprivation of rights under color of law as defined in subsection (3)36 (a)(3) or (a)(4) is a severity level 7, person felony. 37 (4)Deprivation of rights under color of law as defined in subsection 38 (a)(5) where the monetary loss is less than \$1,000 is a class A nonperson 39 misdemeanor. 40 Deprivation of rights under color of law as defined in subsection (5)41(a)(5) where the monetary loss is at least \$1,000 but less than \$25,000 is a severity level 9, nonperson felony. 4243 (6) Deprivation of rights under color of law as defined in subsection 1 (a)(5) where the monetary loss is \$25,000 or more is a severity level 7,2 nonperson felony.

3 (c) A person convicted of deprivation of rights under color of law 4 shall be subject to the provisions of subsection (h) of K.S.A. 21-4704 and 5 amendments thereto.

6 (d) The provisions of this section shall be part of and supplemental 7 to the Kansas criminal code.
