K.S.A. 21-4101 is hereby amended to read as follows: 21-14154101. Disorderly conduct is, with knowledge or probable cause to believe 16 that such acts will alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or 17other breach of the peace: 18(a) Engaging in brawling or fighting; or Disturbing an a religious service, assembly, meeting, or proces-19(b) 20sion, not unlawful in its character; or 21Using offensive, obscene, or abusive language or engaging in noisy (c) 22 conduct tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger or resentment in 23 others. 24 (d) As used in this section "religious service" means a religious ceremony, prayer or other activity according to a form and order prescribed 2526 for worship, including a service related to a particular occasion. 27 Disorderly conduct is a class C misdemeanor. 28 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 21-4101 is hereby repealed.
