## SENATE BILL No. 305

## By Committee on Assessment and Taxation

## 2-6

AN ACT concerning taxation; establishing the tax modernization

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

13 Section 1. (a) There is hereby established the tax modernization 14 commission. 15 (b) The commission shall consist of 20 members to be appointed as 16 follows: 17 Nine members to be appointed by the governor to represent the 18 following interests and contribute expertise as follows: 19 One member shall represent large business; 20 (B) one member shall represent small business; 21 (C) one member shall represent senior citizens; 22 one member shall represent low-income and middle-income (D) 23 families; 24  $(\mathbf{E})$ one member shall represent cities in Kansas; 25 (F) one member shall represent counties in Kansas; 26 (G) one member shall represent educational needs and resources in 27 Kansas; 28 (H) one member who is a professor at a regents institution with ex-29 pertise as an economist; and 30 one member who shall be a licensed tax practitioner; 31 the secretary of revenue or the secretary's designee; 32 one member to be appointed by the president of the senate; 33 (4)one member to be appointed by the speaker of the house of 34 representatives; 35 one member to be appointed by the majority leader of the senate; 36 one member to be appointed by the majority leader of the house 37 of representatives; 38 (7)one member to be appointed by the minority leader of the senate; 39 one member to be appointed by the minority leader of the house 40 of representatives; 41 (9) the chairperson of the standing committee on assessment and 42 taxation of the senate, or like committee;

the chairperson of the standing committee on taxation of the

house of representatives, or like committee;

- (11) the ranking minority member of the standing committee on assessment and taxation of the senate, or like committee; and
- (12) the ranking minority member of the standing committee on taxation of the house of representatives, or like committee.
- (c) The commission shall have the following duties:
- (1) To study the changing nature of the Kansas economy and its relationship to tax revenues and collections and tax fairness and equity;
- (2) to create a blueprint for a tax structure that reflects the changing Kansas economy and that maintains sufficient revenues to provide for effective and efficient state operations long into the future; and
- (3) to recommend legislation necessary to carry out the recommendations of the commission.
- (d) The commission shall organize by the election from its membership of a chairperson and a secretary. The commission may adopt such rules and procedure as the commission deems necessary for the conduct of business. The commission shall meet at least four times a year. The chairperson may call additional meetings. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum. The chairperson may appoint such subcommittees as necessary to assist the commission in its duties.
- (e) Members of the commission attending meetings and subcommittee meetings of such commission shall be paid amounts as provided in subsection (e) of K.S.A. 75-3223, and amendments thereto.
- (f) The commission shall submit a report with the commission's findings and recommendations including any recommendations for necessary legislation to the legislature by the first day of the 2009 legislative session.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
