9 AN ACT concerning the Johnson county park and recreation district;
10 amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 19-2874 and repealing the existing
11 section.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 19-2874 is hereby amended to read as
15 follows: 19-2874. The park district may issue bonds to acquire real estate
16 and may issue bonds to improve the park system or any part thereof. ~~The~~
17 ~~board may submit the question of the issuance of bonds to acquire real~~
18 ~~estate and for the improvement thereof in one proposition. No bonds of~~
19 ~~the park district may be issued unless authorized by resolution of the~~
20 ~~Johnson county board of commissioners.~~

21 *The park board may submit the question of the issuance of bonds to*
22 *acquire real estate and for the improvement thereof in one proposition.*
23 *The proposition shall state the amount of the bonds to be issued and shall*
24 *state the estimated total cost of the repayment of the bonds over the term*
25 *proposed. No bonds shall be issued unless authorized by a majority of all*
26 *the votes cast on the proposition by the qualified electors of the district*
27 *at an election called and held for the purpose. The proposition shall spec-*
28 *ify the purpose for which the bonds are to be issued and the school district*
29 *within which any real estate proposed to be acquired is located. Any*
30 *proposition for bonds for improvements shall describe the kind of im-*
31 *provements proposed to be made but need not specify the amounts to*
32 *be spent for any given improvements.*

33 The bonded indebtedness of the park district shall not exceed 1½% of
34 the assessed taxable tangible valuation of the park district at any one time.
35 Except as otherwise provided, all bonds shall be issued as provided by
36 the general bond law. All bonds issued under this act shall be general
37 obligations of the park district and the park board shall levy taxes upon
38 all assessed taxable tangible property within the park district to pay the
39 bonds and interest thereon as the same mature and come due.

40 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 19-2874 is hereby repealed.

41 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
42 publication in the statute book.
