Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. On and after July 1, 2007, each person employed by the Kansas state school for the blind as a teacher, as defined by K.S.A. 76-11a04 and amendments thereto, or as another professional service provider requiring professional licensure or certification, during a school year shall be paid compensation for such employment at a rate that is not less than the rate of compensation that is paid to a teacher or professional service provider employed by unified school district no. 233, Olathe, Kansas, as of September 1 of such school year, who has comparable or substantially the same levels of education and experience as the person employed by the Kansas state school for the blind or, if no such teacher or professional service provider is employed by such school district for such school year, then such person employed by the Kansas state school for the blind shall be paid compensation at a rate that is not less than the rate of compensation that would be paid to such a teacher or professional service provider employed by unified school district no. 233, Olathe, Kansas, as of September 1 of such school year.

Sec. 2. On and after July 1, 2007, each person employed by the Kansas state school for the deaf as a teacher, as defined by K.S.A. 76-11a04 and amendments thereto, or as another professional service provider requiring professional licensure or certification, during a school year, shall be paid compensation for such employment at a rate that is not less than the rate of compensation that is paid to a teacher or professional service provider employed by unified school district no. 233, Olathe, Kansas, as of September 1 of such school year, who has comparable or substantially the same levels of education and experience as the person employed by the Kansas state school for the deaf or, if no such teacher or professional service provider is employed by such school district for such school year, then such person employed by the Kansas state school for the deaf shall be paid compensation at a rate that is not less than the
