10 AN ACT concerning the Kansas state schools for the blind and the deaf;  
11 relating to the rates of compensation for ~~teachers~~ **certain employees**  
12 employed thereby.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. On and after July 1, 2007, each person employed by the  
16 Kansas state school for the blind as a teacher, as defined by K.S.A. 76-  
17 11a04 and amendments thereto, **or as another professional service**  
18 **provider requiring professional licensure or certification**, during a  
19 school year shall be paid compensation for such employment at a rate  
20 that is not less than the rate of compensation that is paid to a teacher **or**  
21 **professional service provider** employed by unified school district no.  
22 233, Olathe, Kansas, as of September 1 of such school year, who has  
23 comparable or substantially the same levels of education and experience  
24 as the person employed by the Kansas state school for the blind or, if no  
25 such teacher **or professional service provider** is employed by such  
26 school district for such school year, then such person employed by the  
27 Kansas state school for the blind shall be paid compensation at a rate that  
28 is not less than the rate of compensation that would be paid to such a  
29 teacher **or professional service provider** employed by unified school  
30 district no. 233, Olathe, Kansas, as of September 1 of such school year.

31 Sec. 2. On and after July 1, 2007, each person employed by the Kan-  
32 sas state school for the deaf as a teacher, as defined by K.S.A. 76-11a04  
33 and amendments thereto, **or as another professional service provider**  
34 **requiring professional licensure or certification**, during a school year,  
35 shall be paid compensation for such employment at a rate that is not less  
36 than the rate of compensation that is paid to a teacher **or professional**  
37 **service provider** employed by unified school district no. 233, Olathe,  
38 Kansas, as of September 1 of such school year, who has comparable or  
39 substantially the same levels of education and experience as the person  
40 employed by the Kansas state school for the deaf or, if no such teacher  
41 **or professional service provider** is employed by such school district for  
42 such school year, then such person employed by the Kansas state school  
43 for the deaf shall be paid compensation at a rate that is not less than the

1 rate of compensation that would be paid to such a teacher ***or profes-***  
2 ***sional service provider*** employed by unified school district no. 233,  
3 Olathe, Kansas, as of September 1 of such school year.  
4 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
5 publication in the statute book.
