AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, for state agencies; authorizing certain transfers, capital improvement projects and fees, imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing; amending K.S.A. 79-4801 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

- (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.
- (c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of K.S.A. 75-6702 and amendments thereto.
- (d) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 46- 155 and amendments thereto.
