## SENATE BILL No. 367

9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas commission on veterans affairs; pertain-10ing to the membership thereof; pertaining to the executive director thereof; amending K.S.A. 73-1208a and 73-1208c and repealing the 11 12existing sections. 13 14Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 15Section 1. K.S.A. 73-1208a is hereby amended to read as follows: 73-161208a. There is hereby created the Kansas commission on veterans affairs, 17which shall consist of five members appointed by the governor subject to confirmation by the senate as provided in K.S.A. 75-4315b and amend-1819ments thereto. The members of the commission shall be persons who 20have served in the armed forces of the United States. The governor shall 21designate the chairperson of the commission. Members of the commis-22 sion serving on the effective date of this act upon confirmation by the 23 senate as provided in K.S.A. 75-4315b, and amendments thereto, shall 24 continue to serve for the term for which appointed. On July 1, 1986, the 25governor shall appoint one member for a term expiring on June 30, 1987, 26and one member for a term expiring on June 30, 1988. Subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 1992 Supp. 75-4315e 75-4315c, and 2728amendments thereto, the governor shall appoint one member from each 29 congressional district and the remainder from the state at large. Not more 30 than three members shall be members of the same political party; and 31not more than two members shall represent the same veterans' 32 organization. 33 Persons appointed as successors to all members of the commission shall 34 be appointed for terms of four years. The governor may remove a member 35 of the commission for good cause. Any vacancy occurring in the membership of the commission for any cause shall be filled by appointment 36 37 for the unexpired term in the same manner that original appointments 38 are made. Members of the commission shall serve at the pleasure of the 39 governor. Each time a vacancy occurs in the membership of the commis-40 sion for any cause, the chairperson or the chairperson's designee shall 41request in writing a list of three eligible candidates from each congres-42sionally chartered veteran service organization with permanent head-43 quarters in the state of Kansas. The chairperson shall consolidate a list of SB 367

1 all qualified candidates for the position and provide the list to the governor no later than 30 days after the vacancy occurs. The governor shall 2 3 select a qualified replacement from this list. Members of the commission attending meetings of the commission, or attending a subcommittee 4 meeting thereof authorized by the commission, shall be paid compensa- $\mathbf{5}$ tion, subsistence allowances, mileage and other expenses as provided in 6 7 K.S.A. 75-3223, and amendments thereto. 8 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 73-1208c is hereby amended to read as follows: 73-9 1208c. An executive director of the Kansas commission on veterans affairs, who shall be a veteran, shall be appointed by the commission, *subject* 10 to confirmation by the senate as provided in K.S.A. 75-4315b, and amend-11 12ments thereto, and shall serve at the pleasure of the commission chair-13 person. Such executive director shall be in the unclassified service under the Kansas civil service act and shall receive an annual salary fixed by the 1415commission, with the approval of the governor. The executive director 16shall be the executive and administrative officer of the commission and shall be responsible for carrying out the general policies of the commis-17

sion relating to furnishing services to veterans, their relatives and dependents. The executive director shall have such other powers and duties
as the commission shall confer or impose upon the executive director for
the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act.

22 The compensation and expenses of the members of the commission 23 and the executive director of the commission, and the salaries and expenses of officers and employees of the commission, who are employed 24 to carry out the provisions of article 12 of chapter 73 of Kansas Statutes 25Annotated, and amendments thereto, and other expenses of administer-2627ing article 12, shall be paid in accordance with appropriation acts upon vouchers approved by the executive director or by a person or persons 2829 designated by the executive director.

30 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 73-1208a and 73-1208c are hereby repealed.
