9 AN ACT concerning crimes and punishment; creating the crime of au-10tomated teller machine robbery; aggravated automated teller machine 11robbery. 1213 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. (a) Automated teller machine robbery is the taking of 1415property from the person or presence of another by force or threat of 16 bodily harm to any person through the use of an automated teller machine 17transaction. 18(b) Automated teller machine robbery is a severity level 4, person 19felony. 20(c) For the purpose of this section, "automated teller machine" 21means any electronic information processing device located in this state 22 which accepts or dispenses cash in connection with a depositor's account 23 or accounts. 24 (d) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas crim-25inal code. 26Sec. 2. (a) Aggravated automated teller machine robbery is an au-27 tomated teller machine robbery, as defined by section 1, and amendments 28thereto, committed by a person who is armed with a dangerous weapon 29 or who inflicts bodily harm upon any person in the course of such robbery. 30 Aggravated automated teller machine robbery is a severity level (b) 312, person felony. 32 (c) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas crim-33 inal code. 34 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 35 publication in the statute book.
