10 AN ACT concerning district courts; relating to the chief judge; amending 11 K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 20-329 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 20-329 is hereby amended to read as follows: 20-329. In every (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), in every judicial district, the supreme court shall designate a district judge as the chief judge of such district.

(b) In the 18th judicial district, the supreme court shall designate a district judge as district judges of such judicial district shall elect a district judge to serve as the chief judge of such judicial district. The chief judge shall serve for a term of two years. If the chief judge is not reelected or retained in office or resigns or declines to serve, the district judges of such judicial district shall elect another district judge to serve as the chief judge. District judges designated as chief judges on July 1, 2006, shall serve for the remainder of such judge's existing term. (c) The chief judge who shall have general control over the assignment of cases within the district, subject to supervision by the supreme court. Within guidelines established by statute, rule of the supreme court or the district court, the chief judge of each district court shall be responsible for and have general supervisory authority over the clerical and administrative functions of such court.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 20-329 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
