AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning the speed of vehicles; amending 10 K.S.A. 8-1557 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 8-1557 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-14 1557. (a) No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed greater than is rea-15 sonable and prudent under the conditions and having regard to the actual 16 hazards then existing. Consistent with the foregoing, every person shall drive at a safe and appropriate speed when approaching and crossing an 17 18 intersection or railroad grade crossing, when approaching and going 19 around a curve, when approaching a hill crest, when traveling upon any 20 narrow or winding roadway, and when special hazards exist with respect 21 to pedestrians or other traffic or by reason of weather or highway 22 conditions. 23 (b) Any conviction or forfeiture of bail or bond for any violation of 24

- this section shall not be construed as a moving traffic violation for the purpose of K.S.A. 8-255, and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-1557 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
