9 AN ACT concerning retirement and pensions; relating to the Kansas po-10 lice and firemen's retirement system; affiliation by Kansas department of wildlife and parks; membership of certain officers and employees; 11 12employer and employee contributions. 13 14Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 15Section 1. (a) (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 74-4971 16and amendments thereto, on or after the effective date of this act, the 17department of wildlife and parks shall affiliate with the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system established under the provisions of K.S.A. 181974-4951 et seq., and amendments thereto, pursuant to the provisions of 20this act for membership in the system of officers and employees employed 21by the department of wildlife and parks who have successfully completed 22 the required course of instruction for law enforcement officers approved 23 by the Kansas law enforcement training center and are certified pursuant 24 to the provisions of K.S.A. 74-5607a, and amendments thereto, and who 25are employed in a position which such certification is required. For pur-26poses of such affiliation for membership in the system of such members, 27 the department of wildlife and parks shall be considered a new partici-28pating employer. The department of wildlife and parks shall make appli-29 cation for affiliation with such system in the manner provided by K.S.A. 30 74-4954, and amendments thereto, to be effective on July 1, next follow-31ing application. The department of wildlife and parks shall affiliate for 32 membership in the system of such officers and employees for prior and 33 participating service credit. 34 (2) The department of wildlife and parks shall appropriate and pay a 35 sum sufficient to satisfy any obligations as certified by the board of trus-36 tees of the retirement system based on an actuarial valuation of the cost 37 of such affiliation and the employer contributions of the department of 38 wildlife and parks shall be as provided in subsection (1) of K.S.A. 74-4967, and amendments thereto. 39 40 (b) (1) Each such officer and employee employed by the department 41of wildlife and parks on the date of affiliation, may become a member of 42the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system on the first day of the 43 payroll period of such member, coinciding with or following the entry 1 date of the department of wildlife and parks as provided in this section, 2 only by filing with the board of trustees of the system, on or before the 3 entry date of the department of wildlife and parks as provided in this 4 section, a written election to become a member of the system. Failure to 5 file such written election shall be presumed to be an election not to 6 become a member of the system. Such election, whether to become or 7 not to become a member, shall be irrevocable.

Each such officer and employee who is on an authorized leave of 8 (2)9 absence or is in the military service on the entry date of the department of wildlife and parks as provided in this section may become a member 10of the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system on the first day of 11 12the first payroll period of such member, coinciding with such member's 13 return to active employment and payroll of the department of wildlife and parks, only by filing with the board of trustees of the system within 141510 days after such return to active employment a written election to be-16come a member of the system. Failure to file such written election shall be presumed to be an election not to become a member of the system. 1718Such election, whether to become a member or not to become a member, 19shall be irrevocable.

(c) Each such officer and employee who is employed by the department of wildlife and parks on or after the entry date of the department
of wildlife and parks into the Kansas police and firemen's retirement
system as provided in this section shall become a member of the Kansas
police and firemen's retirement system on the first day of such
employment.

(d) If the department of wildlife and parks affiliates as provided in
this act and each such officer and employee who elects to become a
member as provided in this act, the department of wildlife and parks and
each such officer and employee shall be subject to the provisions of K.S.A.
74-4951 et seq., and amendments thereto, as applicable.

(e) The division of the budget and the governor shall include in the
budget and in the budget request for appropriations for personnel services the amount required to satisfy the employer's obligation under this
act as certified by the board of trustees of the system, and shall present
the same to the legislature for allowance and appropriations.

(f) The determination of retirement, death or disability benefits shall
be computed upon the basis of "credited service" as used in K.S.A. 744951 et seq., and amendments thereto, but shall include only participating
service with the person's participating employer, commencing on and
after the effective date of affiliation by the participating employer with
the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system.
