9 AN ACT concerning certain employees at state educational institutions; 10 amending K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 76-715a and repealing the existing sec-11tion; also repealing K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 76-715b. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 76-715a is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 76-715a. (a) As used in this section: 16(1)"State board" means the state board of regents. 17(2)"Institution" means a state educational institution as defined by 18K.S.A. 76-711, and amendments thereto, and the university of Kansas 19medical center. 20(a) (b) (1) The state board of regents, in accordance with the provi-21sions of this section, may authorize any state institution of higher edu-22 eation to convert any or all classified staff employee positions or any 23 portion thereof in at the institution to the unclassified service of state 24 employment. Except as provided by this section, those classified staff 25employees whose positions are converted from classified to unclassified 26status shall retain all health and flexible benefits and leave and retirement 27benefits provided to them under the state classified employee system. 28Each 29 (2)Prior to seeking authorization to convert positions from classified 30 to unclassified status, the institution designated by the board shall develop 31a plan for a system for administration of all other aspects of employment 32 for these employees the employees in such positions, including personnel 33 policies and procedures, and each such system of administration. Each 34 *such plan* shall be subject to approval by the state board of regents. Such. 35 The personnel policies and procedures of such plans shall include a dis-36 ciplinary and grievance process which provides for the right to appeal and 37 due process procedures. Development of such plan shall be subject to 38 input from affected classified employees. Implementation of this section 39 shall not cause a salary reduction or layoff of any classified employee. This 40 section shall not be implemented by The state board of regents at shall not authorize any state institution of higher education to convert classified 4142positions to unclassified positions under this section unless an election has

been held for classified staff employees affected by such proposal at such

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1 institution and the classified staff employees voting at the election by majority vote of all affected classified staff employees approve the con-2 version of the classified staff employee positions affected by such proposal 3 at that institution to unclassified positions. Any such election held after 4 the effective date of this act shall be preceded by an official announce- $\mathbf{5}$ ment providing at least 90 days notice of the date, time and place of the 6 7 election. After a vote of approval, the state educational institution shall provide all affected employees with opportunities for input into the de-8 9 velopment of the plan that is to be presented to the state board of regents. The state board may authorize any institution to enhance annual 10 (c)leave benefits for employees in the classified service or who are designated 11 12as university support staff. Any plan for the enhancement of annual leave 13 benefits shall be subject to approval by the state board. (b) (d) For the limited purposes of this section, and K.S.A. 74-4925, 1415 and amendments thereto, these newly designated unclassified employees shall be referred to as "university support staff" and the university of 16 Kansas medical center shall be considered a state institution of higher 1718education an institution separate from the university of Kansas, Lawrence, and its campuses. 19(e) (e) Nothing in this act shall affect the representation rights of 20collective bargaining organizations that represent employees of a state 2122 institution of higher education an institution, nor shall the provisions of 23 this act affect any term or condition of any collective bargaining agreement in effect on the effective date of this act. 24

(f) The state board may adopt any policies and rules and regulations
 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 76-715a and 76-715b are hereby repealed.
Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
publication in the statute book.

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
