AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to school finance; amend-11 12 ing K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 72-6455 and repealing the existing section. 13 14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 15 K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 72-6455 is hereby amended to read as 16 follows: 72-6455. The high density at-risk pupil weighting of each school 17 district shall be determined by the state board as follows: 18 (a) Except as provided by subsection (d), if the district has an enrollment of less than 40% 35% at-risk pupils, the state board shall multiply 19 20 the number of at-risk pupils enrolled in the district by 0. The product is 21 the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district. 22 (b) Except as provided by subsection (d), if the district has an en-23 rollment of at least 40% but less than 50% at-risk pupils, the state board 24 shall multiply the number of at-risk pupils by .04 in school year 2006-25 2007, by .05 in school year 2007-2008 and by .06 in school year 2008-26 2009 and each school year thereafter. The product is the high density at-27 risk pupil weighting of the district. 28 -If the district has an enrollment of at least 35% but less than 50% 29 at-risk pupils, the state board shall: 30 Subtract 35% from the percentage of at-risk enrollment in the 31 district; 32 multiply the amount determined under paragraph (1) by .006466 33 in school year 2008-2009 and each school year thereafter; and 34 -multiply the number of at-risk pupils enrolled in the district by 35 the product determined under paragraph (2). The product is the high 36 density at-risk pupil weighting of the district. (e) If the district has an enrollment of 50% or more at-risk pupils, 37 38 the state board shall multiply the number of at-risk pupils by .08 in school 39 year 2006-2007, by .09 in school year 2007-2008 and enrolled in the dis-40 trict by .10 in school year 2008-2009 and each school year thereafter. The 41 product is the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district. 42 (d) If the district has an enrollment of at least 35.1% at-risk pupils 43 and an enrollment density of at least 212.1 pupils per square mile, the

 state board shall multiply the number of at-risk pupils by .08 in school year 2006-2007, by .09 in school year 2007-2008 and by .10 in school year 2008-2009 and each school year thereafter. The product is the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district.

- Section 1. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 72-6455 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-6455. The high density at-risk pupil weighting of each school district shall be determined by the state board as follows:
- (a) Except as provided by subsection (d), If the district has an enrollment of less than 40% 44% or fewer at-risk pupils, the state board shall multiply the number of at-risk pupils enrolled in the district by 0. The product is the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district.
- (b) Except as provided by subsection (d), if the district has an enrollment of at least 40% but less than 50% at-risk pupils, the state board shall multiply the number of at-risk pupils by .04 in school year 2006-2007, by .05 in school year 2007-2008 and by .06 in school year 2008-2009 and each school year thereafter. The product is the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district.
- (b) If the district has an enrollment more than 44% but less than 55% at-risk pupils, the state board shall:
- (1) Subtract 44% from the percentage of at-risk enrollment in the district;
- (2) multiply the amount determined under paragraph (1) by .01 in school year 2008-2009 and each school year thereafter; and
- (3) multiply the number of at-risk pupils enrolled in the district by the product determined under paragraph (2). The product is the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district.
- (c) If the district has an enrollment of 50% 55% or more at-risk pupils, the state board shall multiply the number of at-risk pupils by .08 in school year 2006-2007, by .09 in school year 2007-2008 and enrolled in the district by .10 .01 in school year 2008-2009 and each school year thereafter. The product is the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district.
- (d) If the district has an enrollment of at least 35.1% at-risk pupils and an enrollment density of at least 212.1 pupils per square mile, the state board shall multiply the number of at-risk pupils by .08 in school year 2006-2007, by .09 in school year 2007-2008 and enrolled in the district by .10 .01 in school year 2008-2009 and each school year thereafter. The product is the high density at-risk pupil weighting of the district.
