## **HOUSE BILL No. 2607**

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 $\,$  AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to healthy weight education programs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "healthy weight education program" or "program" means a program established and maintained by the board of education of a school district for the purpose of providing middle school students education on issues relating to obesity and excess body weight, the health consequences of obesity and excess body weight, the benefits of maintaining a healthy body weight, prevention and intervention efforts to improve student health by reducing the risks associated with obesity and excess body weight and providing teacher education relating to such program.

- (b) The board of education of each school district may establish and maintain a healthy weight education program and, commencing with school year 2008-2009, may apply for a grant of state moneys for the purpose of providing funding for such program.
- (c) To be eligible to receive a grant of state moneys for the maintenance of a healthy weight education program, a board of education shall submit to the state board of education an application for a grant and a description of the program. The application and description shall be prepared in such form and manner required by the state board and shall be submitted at a time to be determined and specified by the state board. Approval by the state board of the program and the application is prerequisite to the award of a grant.
- (d) Each board of education which is awarded a grant for maintenance of a healthy weight education program shall make such periodic and special reports of information to the state board of education as it may request.
- (e) The state board of education may adopt rules and regulations for the administration of healthy weight education programs and shall:
- (1) Establish standards and criteria for evaluating and approving programs and applications of school districts for grants;
  - (2) evaluate and approve programs;
  - (3) be responsible for awarding grants to school districts;

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- (4) provide any board of education, upon request, with technical advice and assistance regarding the establishment and maintenance of a healthy weight education program or an application for a grant of state moneys;
- (5) request of and receive from each school district which is awarded a grant for maintenance of a program reports containing information with regard to the effectiveness of the program; and
- (6) adopt any rules and regulations necessary for the implementation of this section.
- (f) Subject to the availability of appropriations for healthy weight education programs maintained by school districts, and within the limits of any such appropriations, the state board of education shall determine the amount of grants to be awarded to school districts. When determining the amount to be awarded to a school district, the state board shall give consideration to the number of pupils enrolled in the school district. Upon receipt of a grant of state moneys for the maintenance of a healthy weight education program, the amount of the grant shall be deposited in the general fund of the school district. Moneys deposited in the general fund of a school district under this subsection shall be considered reimbursements for the purpose of the school district finance and quality performance act.
- (g) Nothing in this section shall be construed as precluding school districts from including students who are not obese or who do not exceed a healthy body weight in the healthy weight education program of the district.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
