9 AN ACT concerning elections; authorizing county commission to conduct all elections by mail in ballots; amending K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 25-10 432 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 25-432 is hereby amended to read as 15 follows: 25-432. An election shall not be conducted under this act unless: 16 (a) The board of county commissioners passes an ordinary resolution 17 declaring that all local, state and federal elections in that county shall be

 $\ensuremath{\langle \mathbf{a} \rangle}(b)$ conducted on a date, mutually agreed upon by the governing body of the political or taxing subdivision and the county election officer, not later than 120 days following the date the request is submitted by the political or taxing subdivision; and

- $\overline{\text{(b)}}$ (c) the secretary of state approves a written plan for conduct of the election, which shall include a written timetable for the conduct of the election, submitted by the county election officer; and
 - (e) (d) the election is nonpartisan; and

- $\frac{\text{(d)}}{\text{(e)}}$ the election is not one at which any candidate is elected, retained or recalled; and
- (e) (f) the election is not held on the same date as another election in which the qualified electors of that subdivision of government are eligible to cast ballots; and
- 32 $\frac{\langle f \rangle}{\langle f \rangle}(g)$ the election is a question submitted election at which all of the 33 qualified electors of one of the following subdivisions of government are 34 the only electors eligible to vote:

- 10 (12) Johnson county park and recreation district organized under 11 K.S.A. 19-2859, and amendments thereto;
- 12 (13) sewage disposal districts organized under K.S.A. 19-27,140, and 13 amendments thereto;
- 14 (14) water districts organized under K.S.A. 19-3501 et seq., and 15 amendments thereto; or
- 16 (15) transportation development districts created pursuant to K.S.A. 17 2007 Supp. 12-17,140 et seq., and amendments thereto.
