9 AN ACT concerning county treasurers; amending K.S.A. 19-501 and re-10 pealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 19-501 is hereby amended to read as follows: 19-14501. Each county treasurer elected at the general election in 1976 2004 15shall serve until the second Tuesday in October of 1981 Monday in 2009 16 and until a successor is elected and qualified. At the general election in 171980 2008, and every four (4) years thereafter, a county treasurer shall 18be elected in each county for a term of four (4) years, commencing on 19the second <del>Tuesday in October</del> Monday in January following the election, 20and until a successor is elected and qualified. Such county treasurer shall, 21Before entering upon the duties, of the office the county treasurer shall 22 execute to the state of Kansas a corporate surety bond issued by a com-23 pany authorized to do business in this state and approved by the board 24 of county commissioners in an amount of not less than twenty-five thou-25sand dollars (\$25,000) \$25,000. Such bond, with the approval of the board 26endorsed thereon by the clerk, shall be filed in the office of the county 27 clerk. In the event If the board of commissioners shall not be in session 28does not meet in time for any county treasurer to present such bond for 29 their approval as above specified, or such county treasurer shall be unable, 30 for any reason, is unable to present such bond at any regular meeting of 31the board after due notice of such county treasurer's election, such county 32 treasurer may present such bond to the <del>chairman</del> chairperson or clerk of 33 the board for approval, and the approval endorsed thereon shall have the 34 same effect as if done approved by the board of county commissioners. 35 In the event If the amount of the bond is approved by only the <del>chairman</del> 36 *chairperson* or the clerk of the board, it shall not be less than twice the 37 amount of all moneys directed by the board to be levied in the county 38 during the previous year. 39 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 19-501 is hereby repealed. 40 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

41 publication in the statute book.
