9 AN ACT concerning immigration; requiring the adjutant general to re-10 quest certain information from the United States immigration and customs enforcement and to establish communications with certain for-11 12eign countries. 13 14Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 15Section 1. (a) The adjutant general shall on at least a monthly basis 16make a request for information to the United States immigration and 17customs enforcement that includes a list of the individuals that were living 18in Kansas, but have been deported within the month immediately prior 19to the date on which the request is made because such individuals did 20not possess the legal documentation required to be in the United States, 21and the corresponding country of origin for each individual. 22 (b) Upon receipt of the information included in the adjutant general's 23 request pursuant to subsection (a), the adjutant general shall establish 24 communication with the appropriate office in each foreign country in-25cluded in the list to obtain the names of citizens of such country that have 26applied and received the appropriate documentation to enter and work 27 in the United States. The adjutant general shall also offer any assistance 28which the adjutant general may provide under the laws of the United 29 States to help such citizens immigrate to the United States and the state 30 of Kansas. 31(c) Any employer who has an employee who is deported because such 32 employee did not possess the legal documentation required to be in the 33 United States may contact the adjutant general's office and report the 34 loss of such employee and the need for a new employee to fill that po-35 sition. The adjutant general shall use such reports in completing his re-36 quest for information as required in subsection (a). 37 (d) The adjutant general may adopt rules and regulations necessary 38 to carry out the provisions of this section. 39 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 40publication in the statute book.
