9 AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to school finance; amend-10 ing K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 72-6448 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 72-6448 is hereby amended to read as 14follows: 72-6448. (a) (1) As used in this subsection, "pupil" shall have the 15meaning ascribed thereto in K.S.A. 72-6407, and amendments thereto. 16If the number of pupils enrolled in a district on February 20, of (2)17each school year has increased from the number of pupils enrolled in the district on the preceding September 20, by at least 25 pupils or by a 1819number equal to 1% or more of the district's enrollment, the enrollment 20of the district for such school year shall be determined on February 20. 21The state board shall compute the general fund budget of a school (3)22 district as follows: 23 (A) Compute the general fund budget of the district using the enroll-24 ment of the district on February 20 of each school year; 25compute the general fund budget of the district using the enroll-(B)26 ment of the district on the preceding September 20 of such school year; 27 (C)subtract the amount determined under paragraph (B) from the 28amount determined under paragraph (A); 29 multiply the difference obtained under paragraph (C) by .50; and (D)30 add the product obtained under paragraph (D) to the amount (E)31determined under paragraph (B). The sum is the general fund budget of 32 the school district. 33 (4)This section shall be subject to the provisions of subsection (b). 34 As used in this section subsection, "pupil" means a person (b) (1) 35 who is a dependent of a full-time active duty member of the military 36 service or a dependent of a member of any of the United States military 37 reserve forces who has been ordered to active duty under section 12301, 38 12302 or 12304 of Title 10 of the United States Code, or ordered to full-39 time active duty for a period of more than 30 consecutive days under 40 section 502(f) or 512 of Title 32 of the United States Code for the pur-41poses of mobilizing for war, international peacekeeping missions, national 42emergency or homeland defense activities. 43 (b) If the number of pupils enrolled in a district on February 20, HB 2777

of moneys for general state aid which are in addition to the amount of
moneys appropriated for general state aid for fiscal year 2008.
