9 AN ACT relating to antique vehicles; concerning certain license plates; 10amending K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 8-172 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 8-172 is hereby amended to read as 14follows: 8-172. (a) Except as provided in subsection (c), license plates 15issued for antique vehicles shall be distinctive and shall contain the words 16"Kansas" and "antique" and there shall be no year date thereon. The 17numbering system shall consist of combinations of not more than seven 18letters of the alphabet or numerals or a combination of such letters and 19numerals. The combinations of such letters and numerals shall be at the direction of the director of vehicles, except that any person owning an 2021antique vehicle, other than an antique motorcycle, may make application 22 for a special combination of letters and numerals not exceeding seven. 23 Antique motorcycle license plates shall be the same as other antique ve-24 hicle license plates, except the numbering system shall consist of not more 25than five letters of the alphabet or numerals or a combination of letters 26 and numerals. Such application shall be made in a manner prescribed by 27 the director of vehicles and shall be accompanied by a special combination 28fee of \$40. Unless the combination of letters or numerals designated by 29 the applicant have been assigned to another antique vehicle registered in 30 this state, or unless the combination of letters or numerals designated by 31the applicant have a profane, vulgar, lewd or indecent meaning or con-32 notation, as determined by the director, the division shall assign such 33 combination of letters to the applicant's vehicle. 34 (b) In addition to the fees required under subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-35 167, and amendments thereto, and subsection (a) or (c) of this section, 36 the registration fee for any antique vehicle shall be \$40 and once paid 37 shall not be required to be renewed. 38 (c) In lieu of the license plate issued under subsection (a), a person 39 who owns an antique vehicle who wants to display a model year license 40 plate on the vehicle shall make application in a manner prescribed by the 41director of vehicles, including the execution of an affidavit setting forth 42that the model year license plate the person wants to display on the per-43 son's antique vehicle is a legible and serviceable license plate that origiHB 2786

1 nally was issued by this state or a license plate originally issued by a Kansas city or a reproduction of such city issued license plate. Except for 2 3 license plates issued prior to 1921, such license plate shall be inscribed with the date of the year corresponding to the model year when the 4 vehicle was manufactured. For license plates issued prior to 1921, such 5license plate shall be the license plate issued by the state or a Kansas city 6 7 or a reproduction of such city issued license plate corresponding to the model year when the vehicle was manufactured. Duplicate numbers for 8 9 any year shall not be allowed for any model year license plate under the provisions of this subsection. Upon application to display a reproduction 10 of a city issued license plate, the division of vehicles shall issue a number 11 12to be used for such reproduction license plate. The model year license 13 plate fee shall be \$40. (d) In addition to the license plates authorized under subsection (a) 1415 or (c), a person who owns an antique vehicle may display a model year 16 license plate originally issued by the state of Kansas or a Kansas city or a reproduction of such city issued license plate on the front of an antique 1718vehicle. Except for license plates issued prior to 1921, such license plate 19shall be inscribed with the date of the year corresponding to the model 20year when the vehicle was manufactured. For license plates issued prior 21to 1921, such license plate shall be the license plate issued by the state 22 or a Kansas city or a reproduction of such city issued license plate cor-23 responding to the model year when the vehicle was manufactured. 24 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 8-172 is hereby repealed.
